

Artist Eligibility: Action Greensboro's Public Art Initiative's Artist Invitational is open to invited professional artists who reside in **North Carolina** with experience in implementing and working in the public arena. Artists must be able to effectively work within the project timeline and budget and collaborate with multiple governmental and community agencies.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The Greensboro Downtown Greenway LLC will manage the application and selection process. A Public Art Selection Panel will review applications. The Panel will include local arts professionals, and city, community and Bicentennial representatives. The Panel will review the submissions and select an artist to prepare a proposal to be presented to the Public Art Selection Panel at the offices of Greensboro Downtown Greenway LLC, 317 South Elm Street, Greensboro, NC.

Final Proposal Due: January 30, 2012

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. CD with a set of 10 digital images or slides of art works accompanied by an annotated list including name of Artist, title of work, media, and location of artwork, project budget, slide number and any other relevant information.
2. A professional resume and an artist's statement stating interest in the project, artists' approach to public art, and in particular this project, and relevant past experience on projects of a similar scope and budget.
3. A self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of your materials, otherwise we will keep submitted materials on file for future use. If requested, materials will be returned in January of 2012.
4. Submitted materials must be postmarked by November 8, 2011.
